Reception Area

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Could hear 1940's jive music and could see second world war soldiers - Confirmed - Soldiers were billeted at the Manor.
Stewart	Could also hear Yankee Doodle Dandy - Confirmed - there was an American Airbase on the land here.

1st Floor Staircase and Balcony

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Linked with a gentleman by the name of Charles, 6 ft in height, hair to the side, wearing a silk cravat. Felt he once owned the Manor and that he kept saying that the Manor was in financial trouble - Confirmed, Charles Keyser owned the Manor - Confirmed, there was a Charles Edward Keyser who owned the building from 1893-1930 and then his son Charles Norman Keyser from 1930-1939.
Team 2	Did not get much in this area however one of the team felt that two men were fighting and one was pushed over the balcony.
Team 2	One of the team felt a butler on the stairs who suffered with a bad knee.
Team 1	The team did not get anything in this area.
Team 4	The team heard two taps on the wooden banister.

Room M17

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Stewart felt that people staying in this room would feel dizzy and disorientated and also suffer headaches. He also felt that people would not want to sleep in this room and be asked to move - Confirmed, over the years a few guests have been asked to be moved from this room as they felt discomfort.
Stewart	Stewart felt that an energy over by the chair.
Stewart	Also felt that at times the taps would turn on by themselves.
Stewart	Felt the male and female energies in this room and also felt a vortex present.
Team 1	No activity reported.
Team 3	In this room the team were asking out and the kettle that was on the side switched itself on and off again. No one was near the kettle when this happened.
Team 3	Using the dowsing rods the team linked with an energy that died in a fire but not at the Manor.

Room M8

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Stewart could not physically step into this room, clients when in this room felt ill, stomach ache. A few clients felt a strong female energy.
Stewart	Again felt people staying in this room would not of liked it and asked if they could move rooms - Confirmed, the Manor have advised that they have had a few guests asked to be moved from this room
Team 2	3 of the team moved into the area past room M9 and one of the team picked up a woman possibly called Dawn who was worried about Alan. Dawn was a carer. One of the other clients picked up an image of an old 1920's wheelchair.
Team 1	The team tried glass divination and got very slight movement only.
Team 3	On of the crew felt like there face has been stroked gently.
Team 3	Felt cold breezes, very specifically crossing the circle that they were sat in - no cause found.
Team 3	One of the team was extremely cold and they were asking whether the energy was stood behind her and the dowsing rods they were using at the time gave a yes answer.
Team 3	Another team member was also getting very cold.
Team 3	Heard knocks - however they put these down to the settling of the house and the heating.
Team 3	Stewart felt there were three energies in this room one of which was called Thomas. He felt that he was a young man with curly brown hair.

Room M1

Investigators	Activity
Stewart	Felt this room had poltergeist activity.
Stewart	Felt that women had worked with Ouija boards in this area.
Stewart	When in this room with some of the clients, some felt sick.
Stewart	Linked with a female energy named Mary.
Stewart	Felt there was a major fire here - Confirmed, the fire started on January 13th, 1843 and most of the Manor was destroyed.
Team 2	3 of the team went and sat in the bathroom, one of the team picked up a lady being strangled. Kerry sat in the bath and felt nothing.
Team 2	Two of the team could feel two men fighting in this area which was part of the building damaged by fire.

Restaurant

Investigator	Activity
Team 2	The team did not pick up much in this area.
Team 1	Stewart felt an energy in the far right hand corner. One of the clients offered to sit in this area. Stewart started to link in with a male energy called Thomas (this person did not live at the Manor) who was very agitated and screaming FIRE FIRE at Stewart. The temp in the room started to drop, a few clients felt heat round their faces and then all of sudden a massive bang was heard on the floor and under investigation they found a large torch on the floor that had been knocked off the table, with nobody near it.
Team 1	A few noises were heard, but not conclusive as it could have been the radiators cooling down.
Team 3	Nothing happened
Team 4	The team linked with a Scottish gentleman known as Dougal Macleod, aged 44 who was a soldier.

Team 3	On an EVP experiment the team had a whisper/whistling noise after a question about a military man. Confirmed - Military were posted here.
