This report is a compilation of the Ghost Walk and the group vigils throughout the night.

Rear of House

Investigator	Activity
Celia	Felt that there was a connection with Spain - Confirmed by Alan Turton
Celia	Felt that the area just out the rear of the existing house was more sloped and was surrounded by sheep and farmland. Also that there was a brook at the rear. - Confirmed
Celia	Was shown a horse which would have been used for battle. It was built like a Shire horse but not as high. Also shown a flag holster and two drums. - Confirmed
Celia	An energy came through to Celia wearing a helmet which was turned up at the front and the back. He was not wearing any chainmail but more of a thick body warmer which may have been made from horse hair - Confirmed
Celia	More energies started to come through, David, Charles, Alexander and Pierre. David had a Welsh connection to Monmouth and Port Talbot. She also heard a voice saying 'Calling all tribes'...
Celia	Two more energies connected, Peter and Rupert. Rupert was a well known gentry and had connections to France and the Crusades. - Confirmed

Citadel Ruin

Investigator	Activity
Celia	Showed Alan where canons would have been stationed - Confirmed
Celia	Was told that some of the canons were from around 1200 - 1400.
Celia	There was a large battle here around 1100 - Confirmed
Celia	Canons were also here between 1600-1700 - Confirmed
Celia	Connected with an energy called Sullivan who was a Naval commander from Nelsons period. Also had the name Margaret and Jessop given to her.
Celia	Was shown a massive house - Confirmed
Celia	Inside the ruin she was shown a smoke house, a field hospital and that women would have fought in one of the battles here. The women would have fought here before William the Conquerer's time - Confirmed
Celia	Was shown that there was a severe fire here - Confirmed
Celia	Was also shown many smaller houses and an arsenal of weapons - Confirmed
Celia	Was told that there had always been a structure of some sort here which would have been a stronghold on the path to London - Confirmed
Celia	Was shown two battles, Romans / Saxons and also a battle in Charles II era - Confirmed
Team 1	Saw the shadow of a man running along a passageway near the kitchen area, a few orbs captured on film.
Celia	Heard horses hooves in the Tudor Cellar area
Leigh	Heard a strange rustling noise but decided it was probably an animal
Team 1	Felt uneasy in a particular area in the ruin, it was the same place where Alan Turton has had similar reports.
Team 2, Andrew	Andrew connected with an energy called George and felt that he was in a state of panic and terror. George was telling everyone that 'they were coming, get away!'. Whilst Andrew was asking the energy to come close the video camera footage was going in and out of focus. This happened each time Andrew asked the energy to come close, no explanation found. The camera was working perfectly before and after this connection
Andrew	Heard horses hooves, at a different time to Celia
Team 2	The team felt uneasy sat around the well

Site of Barracks

<u>Investigator</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Celia	Pointed to an area up the hill and said that she could see an army barracks of around 1670 - Confirmed (date a little earlier)
Celia	Felt that there was a blacksmith on this site who would make weapons. There was also a chapel here - Confirmed
Celia	Felt that there were lots of bodies buried around the front of the existing house - Confirmed
Celia	Was shown a variety of wells on this site - Confirmed
Celia	Was told that there was a connection with the Romans and then the Saxons at this location. She was shown a high ranking Roman who was buried within a 10 mile radius, he was the owner of a villa and was buried with his horse - Confirmed (Silchester is about 8 miles away)
Celia	Was told that there had been several hard battles here over the centuries - Confirmed
Team 1	Had a slight fluctuation on the EMF detector, there are no electrical cables in this area
Team 1	Connected with 2 saxon children through dowsing
Team 2	EMF went up to 3 on two different occasions, no explanation found
Team 2	Through dowsing made a connection with a Roman centurion

Canon Area

<u>Investigator</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Team 1	Made a connection with an energy claiming to be William Paulet by the canon. A picture was taken and a strange mist appeared on the photo - see Evidence section
Celia	Connected with an energy called Anthony
Team 2	Made a connection through dowsing with an energy called Martha
Celia	Heard musket fire
Team 3	Connected to an energy called William by the canon (It is interesting that Team 1 had the same name which was unknown by either team at the time of investigating) We asked William to touch our hands and all but one felt a slight 'pins and needles' sensation
Andrew	Felt a Saxon lady come close and this was confirmed by dowsing rods
Jon	Asked the Saxon lady to touch him, suddenly Jon jumped a mile and claimed to have been hit by a moth on his neck. However, using the rods the Saxon lady claimed it was her that touched Jon. (Jon is undecided on what it actually was!)
Andrew	Felt that the cannon was not one that was used here - Confirmed
