This report is a compilation of the Ghost Walk and the group vigils throughout the night.

Museum

Investigator	Activity
Team 3	Motion detector in the tower part of the museum was activated - no cause was found
Team 3	1 member of the team felt very hot
Team 3	Footsteps were heard - no cause found
Team 3	At 23:40 a wind noise and a bang were heard, checked outside and all was calm, very strange!
Team 3	Flashing lights witnessed by 3 members of the team - no cause found
Team 3	Thought the temp gun was faulty as the readings were very high, when returning to the meeting room and on all other vigils the readings were deemed normal - no cause found
Team 3	On a return visit to the museum, 1 member felt a man was present and didn't want them there, she felt sick, sweaty and really hot, another member of the team took some photos and had pictures of 'orbs'
Team 1	Connected with a male in his 20's, was friendly enough but didn't want them there, he was around during Henry VIII era had 3 children and a common-law wife, he died of natural causes.
Team 5	Creaking sounds were heard along with footsteps, everyone was stood still - no cause found
Team 5	One asking for a sign that spirit was with the team, the door between the two rooms moved significantly - no cause found for the movement
Team 2	1 member of team had pins and needles in legs and 1 member of the team did not feel comfortable in the area.
Team 2	Members of the team felt sadness by the seat near the window.
Team 2	Entrance door slammed shut, no wind and opens inwards! - no cause found
Team 2	When departing the doors inside the museum slammed shut! - no cause found

Discovery Centre

Investigator	Activity
Team 3	1 member of the team felt ill and quite sick in this area - no reason for this!
Team 3	Flashing lights were seen and temperature gun physically shook - no cause found
Team 3	All felt it was freezing cold but temp gun showed 108oF, back in the meeting room the temp gun was reading normal temperatures - no cause found
Team 3	1 member of the team had a headache and the crystal was swinging like someone was pulling on it!
Team 1	Connected with a female in her early 20's from the 12th Century, had the name Mary but do not think it was connected with this young lady.
Team 1	When the medium held a member of the teams hand the member of the team's legs went stiff and cold, during this there were noises heard on the EMF! - no cause found
Team 5	3 members of the team felt shivery and cold on their backs
Team 5	Lights were seen and temp fluctuated 11oC - no cause found

Crypt

Investigator	Activity
Team 3	Rustling footsteps were heard by 4 members of the team and shadows were seen by 2 members of the team on investigation - no cause found
Team 1	Connected with a lady called Annabel wearing a corset when worked in the crypt during the time of Henry VIII, she died in the 1500's, felt she was murdered and the fatal strike was left hand side below the heart.
Team 1	Heard movement in one corner on investigation is was cold and a blue flash of light was witnessed - no cause found
Team 5	The name Gausbert was given by the medium from 1076 - later confirmed by EH
Team 5	Noises of footsteps were heard and light anomalies.

Battlefield

Investigator	Activity
Team 3	An apparition of a lady in a Victorian red dress was seen by a member of the team, John (medium) linked in and gave the name of Cleves or Clevdon but felt the name was longer, on discussing this with EH staff the description given matched that of none other than The Duchess of Cleveland. - Very happy this was all confirmed
Team 3	A white figure was seen near the trees and near the steps, banging noises were also heard - no cause found

Abbey Ruins

Investigator	Activity
Team 1	1 member of the team felt her hair being touched - no cause found
Team 5	Smell of rooting flesh / death. - no cause found
Team 2	Felt peaceful then felt an energy of a boy aged between 7 & 8yrs who had been caught stealing and was waiting his punishment, to be whipped.

Guest Rooms

Investigator	Activity
Team 5	Beeps were heard on the Canum - no cause found
Team 5	During the vigil in the last room members of the team were stood facing the doorway against the back wall, everyone who stood in the area were 5-10oC colder on their right arm even when they turned around, thus making what was on the left now on the right!!!! Also when members of the team stood together the person on the left of the chain of people had normal temperature and the last person in the link on their right arm was 10oC colder, everyone in the middle of the link also had normal temperatures on both arms - very strange and cannot be explained!
Team 5	Moving shadow seen and a light was also seen by 1 member of the team.
Team 2	Constant temperature changes and icy cold wind throughout the rooms, breath would be visible one minute then temp would be up to 10oC and fine - no cause found
Team 2	Lots of photo's showing 'orbs'
John	John (medium) took some photos in the rooms and at one stage a clients legs had been replaced by a mist, we will look into this further and post the picture after it has been analysed.

Ice House & Dairy

Investigator	Activity
Team 2	1 member of the team was very cold, mainly on their back
Team 2	When asking for a sign the torch light flickered, on requesting the torch to dim it dimmed then asking for it to shine bright and it did so, when asked 'can you do anything else' footsteps outside like boots on a hard surface were clearly heard - on investigation nobody was out side and no cause found
Team 2	Connected with a male energy who was old and was very happy for the team to be there.

Museum	Motion detector & Dictaphone setup in tower, motion detector was activated not nothing on dictaphone
Discovery Centre	Trigger object placed in the room - no movement made
