Surrounding Grounds

Investigator	Activity
Celia	Felt that at one time the gardens would have been bigger, with archways which the Friars would have walked through saying their prayers
Celia	Connected with people being executed in a nearby square, that they would possibly have been hung drawn and quartered, and witch-hunts might have taken place in the town. - Confirmed
Celia	Felt that there was a Royal visit in 1150 - Confirmed
Celia	Felt that to the left of the Friary there would have been an Orchard many years ago and that there were bodies buried around the trees - Confirmed
Team 2	Nicola felt a pain in her left arm as if someone had grabbed it tightly
Team 2	Rob was filming and saw a flash coming from the Porch Chamber
Team 3	Entrance to the outbuildings activity registered on Canum.
Nick	At the front left of the building Nick experienced stomach pains and felt sick
Celia	Connected with a girl named Martha (17yrs old), had a hot poker on the tongue for gossiping, died of shock.
Team 3	At 2.05am heard motion detector in Porch Chamber beep, they looked up at the window and it lit up with light, they looked away and then back it was in darkness again.
Nick	Went to check motion detector in Porch Chamber, and found a black out blind at the window.
Sam	Experienced a tap on the arm.

First floor Landing and Hall

Investigator	Activity
Celia	Connected with a well-dressed man in a large velvet hat, she felt he would have been connected to King William. Felt that he was an exchequer/consort. He was with a lady by the name of Mary and they stopped off at the Friary on a long journey, he needed a safe place for Mary.
Team 2	Using dowsing connected with Richard from the 17 th Century.
Team 2	Also connected with Mary and William using dowsing established that they were held against their will
Team 2	Heard knocking sounds from towards the far corner of the room on two separate occasions - no explanation could be found
Team 2	Everyone sitting in the circle felt a draught circling round. No noted changes in temperature, however Canum read 10 on the scale

Men's Dorm

Investigator	Activity
Celia	Felt that in 1800's there would have been other walls that separated this room into 3 separate rooms, with a corridor going through. - Confirmed
Team 1	Felt the presence of a spirit; at request tapping sounds on the bunk beds were heard. - No explanation found
Team 1	Using dowsing found that there was the presence of a 12yr old spirit boy named Robert Llewellyn
Lee	Felt the presence of a man, sitting down next to him on the bed.

Women's Dorm

Investigator	Activity
Celia	Felt the temperature drop around her knees, her chest measured 21° and knees 15°
Celia	Felt a connection to sailors and ships - Confirmed the beams in the roof are from a 16 Century ship.
Team 3	Various members of team felt very unsteady under foot.
Team 3	Heard a loud sigh from the corner of the room, caught on camcorder
Team 2	Phil got his head tickled; Nicola felt a heavy pressure on her head also. Three orbs were seen around Nicola, Louise and Elaine.
Team 1	Heard snores although no one was found to be asleep!

Museum

Investigator	Activity
Team 1	Felt the temperature change - Confirmed by temp readings dropped from 19.6° to 13.9°.
Team 1	Witnessed orbs in the fireplace, just after Paul asked the for a spirit energy to show itself.
Sam	Felt the presence of a small boy or man in the fireplace.
Team 2	Rachel's camera switched itself off for no apparent reason - Battery was showing 34mins remaining
Team 2	Felt the presence of a small boy by the fireplace.
Rob	Felt a heavy tap on the top of his head - No reason for this found

Porch Chamber	Group	Motion Detector & Dictaphone - Motion detector made a beeping noise but detector had not gone off, an unusual bang heard on tape.
