Elizabethan Room

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Connected with a lady dressed in Black who would not leave Stewart alone. Very strong energy. The dress would have been big and would have rustled.
Stewart	Felt the whole building was very active. Felt there was an older person who moves amongst visitors. This energy would touch the people and cause cold spots. He moves forward and backwards. Wears white on the chest area and something on his head. Feels this character will be a major influence on the night's investigation.
Stewart	Connected with two children, females one of which is named Anne.
Team 4	Connected with an elderly Naval man who was inspecting the team.
Team 4	Felt one end of the room was very negative and there were lots of shadows. - No cause found
Team 4	Saw numerous flashes of white and red lights. - No cause found
Team 4	Chris felt sick and had to leave the room. Then came Back. Paula then felt sick and left only to return after feeling ok.
Team 4	Another flash of white light on the wall. No cameras were in use. - No cause found
Team 4	All felt quite ill in health in this room.
Team 5	Using glass divination connected to Margaret. Margaret wants the team to find her.
Team 5	Connected with a Duke of Royal blood. Felt he died here but didn't live here.
Team 5	Jackie felt a presence and using the glass established they were connecting with Phyllis Vonssttart. The hands on the glass became freezing cold at this point. The team felt she would have died of a heart condition.
Team 1	Experienced lots of orbs at the start of the vigil but then it calmed down.
Team 3	Connected with a female servant from 1870 - 1880. Died during her working life of natural causes.
Team 3	Connected with a chamber maid in her 30's (34) that died of Rubella. She had blonde hair and a pony tail. Said the Mistress of the house was quite cruel. Blames her employers for her illness as made to work whilst very ill. Her name was Deborah Raymond. She had an infectious laugh and had children. The team called Stewart into help this lady cross over and were successful.

Great Hall

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	The Picture of Elizabeth Holby above the Warwick room is the dress Stewart is seeing. - confirmed. There are a number of pictures dotted around the Abbey but Elizabeth Holby used to call the place home and has been seen in the past.
Stewart	Felt unlucky and unfortunate feelings, wouldn't want to have anything to do with family.
Stewart	Felt Elizabeth was really not happy the team was there. Zapping his energy and feelings of Hatred. This was an important place for her and wants to know why we are here. Felt she would have preferred the company of women. Quite a hard driven person who doesn't like to mess around. Quite verbal and physical when expressing an opinion. - Lady Holby was quite an important figure in history and would often be called to the Royal Court.
Team	During the walk around one of the team experiences an extreme headache.
Stewart	Felt the walkway next to the hall was a very active runway. Possible poltergeist activity here.
Stewart	Could see Black figures in peripheral vision.

Outside

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Connected with residual energy of carriages pulling up outside. Carrying important people but they didn't want to be here. To possibly be held against their will. Possibly Royalty, Queens. Saw the Royal crest on the carriages and felt the outside could be quite active. Again felt the place to be unlucky and that it had a "twist" about it.

Warwick Room

Investigator	Activity
Stewart	Still has Elizabeth with him. She doesn't like him calling her that and feels there would have been something else to her name. - Elizabeth was known as Lady Holby.
Stewart	Felt this was a very important room where lots of important decisions were made.
Stewart	Felt there would have been a building here before this one. - confirmed
Stewart	Connected with a young girl. Was shown the image of playing with a hoop and stick.
Stewart	Connected with a young shy boy who kept coming in and out of the room. He was shy and hard to pin down.
Stewart	Elizabeth is saying "You should know who I am". Felt she would hit children.
Stewart	Connected with a thin male energy who would have been a painter in his time. Felt his life was taken and it was too short. Not keen on what happened to the place after he died,
Stewart	Felt there were things hidden behind these panels still to this day. Possibly a doorway.
Stewart	Felt there would have also been a hidden passageway upstairs.
Stewart	Felt senior Royalty was definitely held here against their will.
Stewart	Felt there would have been burial grounds nearby outside. - These burial grounds are supposed to be under the Tennis courts in the grounds.
Stewart	Connected with a Thomas Hardy. Possibly Thomas or Hardy.
Stewart	Felt a pain in his back.
Stewart	Felt the deaths here were quite natural and nothing too dramatic so far.
Team 5	Stewart and his team joined Steven and Team 5 after reports of extreme activity in this room and the spirit offering to appear during glass divination. High energy levels in room.
Team 5, 1, 3 and 2	Knocks coming from all round the room - No cause found after discounting the radiator.
Team 5	Dining chair rocked on its own from side to side when Stewart was asked to join the team. - No cause found no one was near that end of the room.
Team 5	During glass divination Margaret agreed to appear in front of the team. All witnessed partial manifestation near the door on the wall with the mirrors. White elongated mist appeared out of no where. The room was not cold.
Team 5	Two glasses were used in divination with Stewart and one flew off the table.
Team 5	One of team began to channel Margaret and protested that "she was not a bad person and was a guardian here and that if we continue to say she was bad it will only make her angrier."
Team 5	One of the team began to channel Phyllis but broke the connection with Stewarts help.
Team 5	Witnessed hooded figures surrounding the team around the table.
Team 5	Stewart saw one of the team transfigure into a man with a long hat.
Team 2	During scrying Paul connected with William who was a priest. He was born in 1063 and was a personal priest to a Lady Margaret. He said that he lived quite close by and traveled back to the Abbey each night. Paul mentioned 1097 and the words St Hilda who died here. Paul also mentioned that a child was present in the room and they were playing with the crystals. The team felt that Paul had gone into trance and was channeling as his breathing became very heavy and he was no longer with them.
Team 1	Canum buzzed - No cause found
Team 1	Experienced lots of EMF meter activity. - No cause found
Team 1	Experienced table tapping. - No cause found
Team 1	Heard a "Tut" sound. - No cause found
Team 3	Saw red light beside fire place. - No cause found
Team 3	Saw sparkly lights in corner of room by door. - No cause found
Team 3	Heard "jangle" noises, like keys, in corner of room. - No cause found
Team 3	Heard noise of door slamming. This was picked up on Dictaphone and not by the team at the time. - No cause found
Team 3	Heard shuffling sounds on tape like a dress. - No cause found
Team 3	Heard whistling on tape. - No cause found

Sonning Room

<u>Investigator</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Stewart	Felt this would be active later.
Stewart	Felt there would be lots of orbs and mists in this room.
Stewart	Quite a restful place in the building and was used for entertaining.
Stewart	Still being drawn to the panels on the wall.
Stewart	Felt an energy building up as he concluded the Ghost Walk. Felt people who stayed here for a few days would feel low and drained. Felt Elizabeth was very stubborn but also so miserable. Carrying guilt and weight of the world on her shoulders. She protects this building and has done since the 1500's
Team 4	Connected with Lady Elizabeth Holby
Team 4	Connected with the name Quinton. From the 13 th or 18 th Century. Would have been about 7 years old.
Team 4	During glass divination connected with Sir John from 1729. He was married with children and owned 3 dogs. He was a Master here. His portrait is in the main hall.
Team 4	Paul's Video Camera battery was drained. Team felt it was Quinton. - No cause found
Team 3	Atmosphere of room changed upon entry at 12:30 am. Room became darker.
Team 3	Torch stopped working. - No cause found
Team 3	Heard tapping sounds from fire place. - No cause found
Team 3	Celia became quite emotional.
Team 3	Sue was tight headed and tingling all over.
Team 3	Heard peculiar noises when Ross asked questions. - No cause found

Donning Room

<u>Investigator</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Team 4	Felt the room to be quite oppressive on entry.
Team 5, 4, 3 & 2	Experienced flashes of light on the far wall. - No cause found
Team 4	Felt a cold energy in the middle of the table. - No cause found
Team 4	Glass did move during to divination to two members then stopped.
Team 4	Chris began to channel spirit and confirmed his name was Edward and he was quite young. Team felt he died by a crushing to the chest from horses. When Steven was questioning the energy through Chris when he asked if there were cars or horses around the channeling ceased and left Chris.
Team 4	Using the Planchette produced the letter "e" and "w"
Team 5	Temperature dropped 16 degrees after first Planchette experiment. - No cause found
Team 5	Connected with a lady in waiting called Margaret.
Team 5	Planchette was very active after connecting with Elizabeth and became quite frantic.
Team 5	Stewart performed automatic writing.
Team 5	Using dowsing they connected with a child called Margaret who was happy.
Team 5	Lights, orbs and mists experienced. - No cause found
Team 5	Some saw a partial apparition.
Team 3	Made contact using glass divination.
Team 3	Got knocking sounds in response to calling out. - No cause found

Henry VIII

<u>Investigator</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Team 2	Craig experienced head ache each time he entered room.
Team 2	During séance all witnessed a tap on the table. All teams' hands were joined. - No cause found
Team 2	Julie saw the shadow of a head walk across the room and at the same time all heard a dog whine.
Team 2	Anne experienced a finger tip touch her.
Team 2	Nick felt the heard an insect buzz past his ear.
Team 2	The NID went off 4 times. - No cause found
Team 2	Margaret saw the shadow of the dog walk across to the fire place.
Team 1	Experienced a flash of light. - No cause found
Team 1	The Canum fluctuated madly 3 to 4 times. - No cause found
Team 1	Felt uncomfortable, agitated and nervous.
Team 3	During séance the video camera was turned off right before activity began. - No cause found. Battery had 6 hours left but it was switched off.
Team 3	The room seemed to fill with smoke as if there was a fire or the chimney was blocked but there was no smell. - No cause found
Team 3	Upon request the team heard loud knocking sounds beneath the table. All the team were holding hands and the floor was carpeted. To experiment the team stopped asking questions for a while and the knocking stopped. Straight away when asked if the spirit was still there the knocks began to everyone's amazement in the room. - No cause found.

Experiments

<u>Location</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Glass Divination	Produced very good response in all rooms. Resulting in some case with the glass flying off the table narrowly missing one of the team.
Planchette	Produced the letter "e" and "w" whilst connecting with a spirit called Edward. Was also very productive when in contact with Lady Hoby.
EVP	A number of strange sounds captured and require further analysis
Photography	Interesting image captured during the ghost walk of what appears to be a reflection in part of a mirrored section of the paneled walls. Also a number of orbs and other strange shapes captured.
Automatic Writing	Stewart produced the following writing : "To dream a perfect dream, Love to you all, My time is happy, You are well"
