Team 1	Tapping noises heard in corridor - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 1 - settee area	Smell of rotting things and something dirty - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 2	All the lights went off by themselves - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 2	Lorraine picked up on the name Amy
Team 3	Got the same Samuel Jacobs
Team 3	Drop in temperature, Rachel was 32, Vicky was 20

Group	Feelings of seasick
Ian Lawman	Picked up on a smuggler, with hood and cloak
Group	Picked up on lay preachers
Ian Lawman	Picked up on that the room use to be used fro praying
Ian Lawman	Felt agitated
Group	Picked up on the name of Samuel
Group	Lights seen in the corner of the room - no cause found
Group	Young girl felt in room
Group	Atmosphere horrid in room
Group	No-one liked this room
Group	A lady felt a cold draft round her hand - no cause found
Group	Felt it was a mans room
	Steve tried an experiment to see if we could all point to where we thought a altar would have been in this room - no definite results - Ian didn't think there would have been one.
Team 3	Felt the bed shaking - no cause found
Maria-Clare	Saw a pentagram on the wall

Ian lawman	Picked up on the name Elizabeth
Ian lawman	Picked up on a beautiful lady with Victorian dress and veil - <b>confirmed this lady has been seen before</b>
Ian lawman	Thought there had a been a fire at the inn - <b>confirmed there were 2</b>
Ian lawman	Pick up that a lady had died here during the fire - <b>no definite answer found but most likely</b>
<b>Bedroom</b>	
Team 4	Saw dancing light around the lamp - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 4	Saw curtain move - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 4	Saw a mist around fire - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 4	Fluctuation in temperature
Team 4	Connected with a lady called Elizabeth from 1808
Team 4	Connected with a boy called Mark who died after playing hide and seek and getting locked in the wardrobe, he was 8 ½
Team 4	Pickup up on Sophie who was Mark's twin sister
Team 4	Saw a baby crawling across the floor - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 3	Picked up on the name Emily Anderson/Johnson - who died 1784 aged 18, she had long red/blonde hair, blue eyes and freckles, died of a blood disorder. She had 2 sisters, she had a sister called Sarah who died in one of the fires here.

Ian Lawson	Felt someone would have been shot with a musket - <b>can't confirm by more then likely</b>
Ian Lawson	Felt there were cellars where dead bodies use to be put - <b>confirmed, once people had been hung they would be brought and stored in he cellar</b>
Ian Lawman	Felt this area would have been used as a hospital
Ian lawman	Saw lots of beds like a dormitory - <b>confirmed it use to be one</b>
Group	The lights went off by themselves and after a while came back on - <b>confirmed this happens a lot on investigations, it has nothing to do with the electrics</b>

Group	Several others have this feeling as well
Ian Lawman	Feels sick in room
Ian Lawman	Wants to paint a cross on the door
Ian Lawman	Feels like he needs to cough
Ian Lawman	Picked up that there was lots of murders connected with the place die due to people having their throat cut - <b>can't confirm but more than likely</b>
Group	Dry mouths and feelings of being strangled felt
Ian Lawman	See guys round drinking and laughing
Ian Lawman	See's ladies sat on their knees
Ian Lawman	Felt this would have been a games room
<b>Bathroom</b>	
Ian Lawman	Sees someone laid down
Ian Lawman	Doesn't like it in there, feels negative and feels someone was attacked and raped
Group	Lots of feelings of negativity
Group	Heavy atmosphere
Group	Has a story to tell and feels like if you're in there for two long spirits would channel through you
Group	Hot patches in room - felt before - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 3	Had the name Jacob
Team 3	Felt someone would have died from hanging - suicide
Team 3	Felt the year 1845 was important
Team 3	Felt Jacob might have been fishmonger who was involved with robbery
Team 3	Felt there might have been a well in the room
Team 1	All sensed various fluctuation in light - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 1	Steve felt pressure on his throat, so did Ian and Sue
Team 1	Ian got a dry throat
Team 1	Seems to get colder by far wall by fireplace
Team 1	Steve saw lights in corner by wardrobe
Team 1	Ian felt presence of young child (boy) who suffered from possibly TB or Pneumonia
Team 1	CJ sensed sweet smell like cinnamon or sweet bread - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 1	Ian felt like there was liquid in his mouth
Team 1	Ian could see blue lights around Mark - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 1	Noise was heard in bathroom - <b>no cause found</b>
Team 1	CJ was in bathroom on lone vigil and heard the same noise but thought it came from the bedroom
Team 1	Sue felt anguished presence of lady with her head in her hands and crying, felt she was connected with a small boy
