Shop

<u>Investigator</u>	<u>Activity</u>
Paul	In the upstairs room Paul felt a heaviness and a disorientated feeling in the room.
Paul	Sensed a lady who was quite short, she was a big character and would always make a big entry, she worked in the building 200 years ago.
Paul	Was aware of a young boy (11/12 yrs) on the stairs, wearing clogs, brown shorts and jacket and carrying tools. He sensed a strong smell of shoe polish. He was a mischievous character and links to the lady above.
Paul	Felt that the room upstairs had been used as an office at one time and connected with a gentleman writing in a register with a feather quill.
Paul	Was given the names Ella/Eloise connected to the building.
Paul	In the toilet area, sensed that there was a vortex.
Paul	Sensed a small man wearing grey worn very long trousers, with a beige rag type shirt, and he looked after things stored here.
Paul	In the shop downstairs Paul felt it had had an official use like a police station. In the back room Paul felt that there was a war type connection and felt people had signed a register in there to go and fight.
Team1	Upstairs the candle flickered on request - Team were unsure if this was a breeze)
Team 1	Downstairs in the shop conducted a glass divining experiment. Connected to a female 30-40 years old, with long brown curly hair.
Team 1	Heard tapping noises on several occasions - no explanation found
Team 1	Saw flashing lights near the table - no explanation found
Team 1	Recorded temperature changes on hands
Team 1	Paul felt someone standing behind him
Team 2	Heard knocking in response to questions - no explanation found
Team 2	Felt tingling sensations
Team 2	Someone in the group felt a poke in their bottom - no explanation found!

Courtyard area

Paul	Paul felt like he was standing on the street and this area wasn't originally part of the building. - Confirmed
Paul	Sensed horses, and the smell of manure, horse carrying milk around.

Bar area

Paul	Sensed 5 gentlemen and the surnames Walker and Fielding/Field, (not the usual spelling of Field)
Paul	Sensed someone had fallen to death in this area.
Paul	"Washington" either place or surname connects to the building.
Paul	Hanging would have taken place outside the pub. - Confirmed
Paul	Felt that the pub had strong religious links.

Cellar

Paul	Felt that things were stored secretly
Paul	Felt that conspiracies were plotted in the cellar.
Team 1	Connected with spirit using the crystal dowser, but would not communicate with men.
Team 1	Kelly felt uneasy in the cellar.
Team 3	Experienced very cold sensations - no explanation found
Team 3	Felt the presence of a mischievous pair (man and boy)
Team 3	Members of the team felt unsteady and the feeling of being pushed over
Team 3	Naomi felt physically sick.
Team 3	Heard a knocking sound from the end room - no explanation found
Team 3	Experienced a bad smell which got worse - no explanation found

Museum Room

Paul	Sensed 5 men, who were dangerous and known to everyone in Bolton during their time.
Paul	Felt that in the early 1800's there was a gun kept somewhere in the building
Paul	Felt an unwelcome feeling in the room.
Paul	Felt that there were strong catholic links to the building.
Paul	Sensed a man speaking French in the room
Paul	Sensed a man wearing black boots to the knees, a black jacket with gold buttons.
Paul	Sensed that a lady had been strangled in the room and thrown to the floor hitting her head.
Paul	Felt that there is someone buried under the building.
Team 2	Conducted a table tipping experiment, the table moved from one side of the room to the other (about 3 metres) - no explanation found
Team 2	Felt the presence of 5 males
Team 2	Experienced cold feelings and drafts - No explanation found
Team 3	Conducted a table tipping experiment and the table only rocked slightly.
