This report is a compilation of the group vigils throughout the night.

Rock Room (Upstairs Bar) and Museum Room

Investigators	Activity
Group	Feelings of sickness and dizziness *no explanation found
Stewart Keays	Feeling of a vortex in the room
Group	People being touched on the head * confirmed this has been felt by many people over the years*
Stewart Keays	People seeing a carry cot or child in the corner of the bar
Stewart Keays	A spirit of a man who like to play games on people, like tapping them or moving their drinks.
Stewart Keays	Footsteps heard up there when no-one is around *confirmed all the time*
Stewart Keays	Coughing and Sighing heard when no-one is around
Stewart Keays	Possibly a man called George - 5ft 9 or 10, old style clothing, possible connection with a church but not a clergy man, had something to-do with a child's exorcism that took place in the room around 1700 possible 1730-31.
Stewart Keays	Were people poisoned by their beer?
Team 2	Heard loud footsteps on stairs and saw a person walk past window and hear them walk down the stairs but no-one was there. *confirmed been heard and seen before*
Team 2	Hear a loud sigh in the corner of the room *confirmed*
Team 2	Heard someone whistling *no explanation found
Team 2	Glass moved round the table and connected with a nice energy, then the energy changed and the glass movements became harder. *no explanation found
Team 2	Lots of movement with the pendulum
Stewart Keays	Feelings of uncontrolled anger *confirmed see below*
Group 3	Felt a strong energy in the room, that tried to push Stewart over, the male presence made Lynn feel very angry, but made Lee and Stewart laugh. This energy made Rach feel impatient.
Group 3	Lee, Paul and Rach left the area and Lynn filled with un controllable rage, she screamed and lashed out pushing the table and then collapsing. Then energy passed through Stewart which left him ice cold (and in Rach's words freaking out!)
Team 1	Felt comfortable in bar area if a bit oppressive
Team 1	No movement on the planchette
Team 1	CJ felt angry like someone wanted to say 'get out' and push the table away. He shouted something .. (rude!) really loudly!
Team 1	CJ felt energy was of a man like Charlie Chaplin with a bowler hat, felt very uncomfortable.
Team 1	After this the energy changed and became heavy and colder. Richard felt cold and prickly on the back of his neck. Joanne, Mark and Sue smelt 'bad smells' like mouldy/festering type smell. Joanne had to leave the room as she became unwell.
Stewart Keays	Was their boulders kept in the room? *confirmed*
Stewart Keays	Tables are moved, as are glasses
Stewart Keays	People shoelaces being tied together

Confirmation from Frankie at the Olde Inn: In the Rock room people have reported being touched on the back of the neck/ head, especially around the big table next to the tunnel to the Museum room. There is a spirit that likes to move things around, but he's mainly felt in the museum room.

Footsteps are always heard in there along with coughing and sighing. Uncontrolled anger, again is usually in the museum room.

Museum room - usually the most active room (see above). Very powerful spirit in there, will move around the pub, but is usually in there. He was a very aggressive man and apparently was the equivalent to a hitman in his time. It has been discovered that he murdered 5 people for money, an exchange which happened at the Trip and was killed in revenge. His name was Jack, but tries to disguise himself as a little girl or boy.

Haunted Snug

Investigators	Activity
Everyone	Feelings of being tapped on the head or shoulder <i>*confirmed*</i>

Snug - often people feel like someone is playing with them in there - tapping on head/ shoulder, very innocently, some people report a little girl in there, she is also present in the cellar beneath the snug.

Yorkeys Lounge (downstairs bar)

Investigators	Activity
Stewart Keeyes	Picked up on a lots of energies but felt there was a specific male energy present
Group 3	Feelings of being watch by two men, who walk round the room
Group 3	Feelings of being strangled or having your throat cut
	Bar doors opening on their own
Group 3	Spirit of a chap behind the bar – threatening energy, tall man with brown hair
Team 1	Hearing footsteps from upstairs and coming down the stairs <i>*no explanation found*</i>
Team 1	Standing at the bar looking through, to the chimney Alcove CJ saw an old men in old fashioned cloths drinking. <i>*no explanation found*</i>
Team 1	Sue felt a small boy tugging on her arm who wanted to find his mother who was distressed.
Team 1	Stewart saw a male (tall and dressed in dark clothes) behind Sue.
Team 1	Door of the bar area opened by itself (no breeze detected) <i>*no explanation found*</i>
Team 1	Mark and Stewart heard footsteps outside the door <i>*no explanation found*</i>
Team 1	Moved to the alcove area Stewart, Sue and Joanne felt uncomfortable.
Team 1	Stewart saw a hunched hooded man move to the other bar area
Team 1	Felt a cold breeze. <i>*no explanation found*</i>
Team 1	Via glass divination Joanne felt male energy presence with a beard
Team 1	CJ did a lone vigil and heard footsteps around the bar area when no-one was there. <i>*no explanation found*</i>
Stewart Keeyes	Stewart picked up on a George cross like templar knight and shield coat of arms with a dragon figure <i>*confirmed*</i>

Yorkeys lounge - nothing violent in there to report so far. People often see/ feel Yorkey in there or a judge in the corner under the clock. The alcove was only recently (last 11 years) excavated again after it being blocked for many years due to a faulty chimney - no reports of anything in there.

According to the booklet that the manager gave me, legend has it that the Crusaders stopped off at the Inn for some welcome refreshment, which would tie in with the cross and shield Stewart picked up on.

Ward Room

Investigators	Activity
Team 2	A ladies presence in the third part of the bar area, seen in a red dress.
Team 3	Connected with this lady, she also took a fancy to Lee and stood in front of him so that he became hazy and faded out of focus. <i>*no explanation found*</i>

Ward room - lady in the left hand corner near the ring/ fireplace. Reportedly a prostitute who 'worked' in the bar.

Cellars

Investigators	Activity
Stewart Keeyes	Picked up on the name Henry from the 1800's
Stewart Keeyes	Oldish chap, with a moustache and a long coat
Stewart Keeyes	Felt an energy enter him, his face changed and started to get longer
Stewart Keeyes	Felt caves should be bigger <i>*confirmed*</i>
Stewart Keeyes	Connected with a child energy <i>*confirmed*</i>
Stewart Keeyes	Felt that someone would come and turn the beer taps off
Stewart Keeyes	Heard lots of chatting
Stewart Keeyes	Connected with a man called Bernard
Group 3	Connected with a boy named James aged 8
Group 3	Connected with a young girl <i>*confirmed*</i>
Group 3	Sensed a big man with a beard possible called Jack who worked with the beer barrels. Could have been Irish
Team 1	Felt nothing

Cellars - Man in a long black trench coat style jacket who rushes about throughout the cellars, especially on the stairs near the condemned cell, unsure of the name. On the odd occasion, a young girl is heard in the cellars by the name of Hannah, but only when Jack is there. Sometimes things are moved around, but this can be explained by staff knocking things off by accident when walking through/ deliveries.

The caves were originally bigger and they are connected to the Market Square in the city centre, but have been blocked off by the council for health and safety reasons I believe.

The caves were also at one time cells and were also used for cock fighting.

Doing research, George Henry Ward acquired the inn in about 1880's from the picture I have seen of him, he looks like the man that Stewart described as Henry. Also according to this research George has been seen in the cellars playing tricks on people and apparently moving things round just to confuse them.
